01. **Star Ferry** - Named "One of the 50 Things to Do in Your Lifetime" by *National Geographic Traveler*
02. **A Symphony of Lights** - nightly multi-media show along Hong Kong's skyline
03. **Tsim Sha Tsui Promenade** - Vantage point for Hong Kong Island's spectacular skyline
04. **Avenue of Stars** - Walk of Fame with handprints and statues of Hong Kong celebrities
05. **Aqua Luna Cruise** - Evening Chinese junk tour of the famous Victoria Harbour
06. **1881 Heritage** - Former Marine Police Station, now a cultural and shopping landmark

07. **Hong Kong Palace Museum** - exhibiting artefacts from the National Palace Museum at the Forbidden City in Beijing, China

24. **Clock Tower** - situated at former Kowloon-Canton Railway Station, and a declared monument
25. **Sky 100** - located on the 100th floor of the International Commerce Centre (ICC), Sky 100 is a 360-degree indoor observation deck, which offers views of Hong Kong Island, Victoria Harbour, the Kowloon Peninsula and Tai Mo Shan.
